HARTLEY was present during interview between Detective YEADON and David HARTLEY. She confirmed movements around New Year as provided in David HARTLEY's statement. She indicated that they were at the Federal Hotel in Picton on New Year's Eve until 12.30, when they returned to the yacht. The group arrived at Furneaux on 3 January 1998.

Whilst speaking with Susan I was called away to secure an exhibit located by searchers. No written statement was obtained from Susan HARTLEY. As stated above, she confirmed exactly what her husband David had said.

In addition she also stated that they had heard that a female from the boat "Mama Duck" had taken photographs of Furneaux on New Year's Eve.
